Centre Front fastening All jackets must fastened left over right and must be the true centre front.	
Unless otherwise stated by design	
Hood Must have the lining anchored at the centre seam Hood drawcord exposed length to not exceed 20cm	
Internal Pocket – LHSAW All menswear outerwear coats to have an internal pocket. Bartack either end.	
Horizontally inserted Unless otherwise stated by design	
Facing/ Buggy Hem to be pin hemmed or bound (when garment is unlined).	
Bagged out into seams and lining (when garment is lined).

Lining Do not use cotton in sleeves. Sleeve linings to have mechanical stretch (unless oversized). Apply 2cm curtain. All linings to be fully bagged out.	
CB lining pleat: 2cm Deep minimum.	
Vertical ease pleat: 1cm Deep minimum	
Unlined coats: Bound Edges Used on CB seams, facings, zips, hoods and pocket bags when garments are unlined. All other seams (where design dictates).

Formal Blazers Fuse the back torso and CF revere	
Melton Under Collars: Zig zag stitch attach	
Lapel buttonhole (if required): must be cut open	
Buttons Must have 2 – 3mm shank height and be thread whipped All 4 hole buttons must be X stitched Minimum of 8 loops per button.	MAKE SURE BUTTONS ARE STITUDED ON USING CHOCK LOCKSTITCH Min of 8 choses busys THERAD SHANK LINCTIFT DIRE 5-7 MIN LOW, ALL BUTTONS MUST BE THREAD MINORED

Quilting Filler to be equality distributed Shaping to be as per the design CAD's If true 'down' is requested, this must be accompanied by a quality certificate for authenticity and proof of source	
Zip Guard Used where design dictates.	
Zips Must run smoothly Must sit level Channel must not become caught in the teeth. Must be from a nominated source EP, Graden, Klestro, Opti, TIT, YCC and YKK.	
Waistbands Bagged out and elastic encased. Rib Qualities (See components section).	Themas har and the same
Cuffs Bagged out into lining.	
Cuff Plackets To be bound. Do not use binding on cloths prone to seam slippage.

Jet and Welt Pockets (tailored styles only) To be basted closed. Baste stitch to start 3cm from opening and must not damage cloth when opened.	
Pockets Fusing to be concealed and overlocking must be neat. Pockets must be level and symmetrical (unless design dictates otherwise)	
Poppers To be attached using plastic washers Must be non-rattle	
Pocket Bearers Seam to be concealed Pocket Bags Must not be visible below hems	
Vents and Splits To be secured internally with a back tack. Tailored styles to be tacked closed for delivery.	
Spare Button To be added to the care label
