## Urban Outfitters

Construction Method	<u>Photo</u>
Waistband Options Bagged out or bound Elastic to be encased. Sink Stitches to be concealed under waistband.	
Lining	
Lining  To be bagged out on waistbands and facings	
Twin Needle Used for casual styles and stretch cloths 1cm (unless design dictates otherwise).	
Cover stitch Used for stretch cloths only. Bulk nylon threads to be used	BDC.
2cm Double Turn  To be used in place of binding, twin needle or pin hem.	

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# **Construction Method** Photo Felled Hem Stitch type: Heavy weight fabrics and tailoring 20000000000 4cm deep (unless design dictates otherwise). Pin Hem 0.3cm deep 0.5cm when using lightweight cloths such **Bound Hem** When design dictates. Raw Hem **Woven:** To be finished with a topstitch **Stretch:** To be tacked to prevent seam from running back. **Elasticated or Rib Hem** Bagged out through the cuff using twin needle or cover stitched.

# Gusset lining (tailored styles only)

To be used at the cross fork to conceal the seaming.




#### **Pockets**

Fusing to be concealed and overlocking must be neat.

Pockets must be level and symmetrical (unless design dictates otherwise)



**Pocket bags** to be inserted into waistbands.



#### **Pocket Bags**

Must not be visible below hems



### Fish Eye buttonholes

All bottoms to have fisheye style buttonholes
