Menswear Components

Component	<u>Photo</u>
All components Must be REACH compliant.	http://guidance.echa.europa.eu/
Zip Insertion Bagged out into linings or facings. <u>Do not</u> use cut down zips.	
Zip Insertion Jeans and Denim Semi auto-lock for all fly openings. Fully auto-lock for all other fastenings. Bagged out into linings or facings.	
Zip Quality From nominated sources: EP, Graden, Klestro, Opti, TIT, YCC and YKK.	
Hook and Bar To be inserted before waistband is bagged out. Support with fusing.	
Two and Four Hole Buttons Machine stitched securely through two layers of cloth, supported with fusing. Spare buttons to be provided on all garments. Stitched to care label or kimbled in clear bag.

Shank Buttons Must be stitched then whipped securely. Spare buttons to be provided on all garments. Stitched to care label or kimbled and in a clear bag.	
Button Holes To be fully machine stitched with no raw edges visible. Blade to be sharp. Both layers of cloth to be fused.	
Jigger Buttons To be used on all bottoms with hook and bar or single button fastening (jeans exempt).	
Press Studs, Poppers and Rivets Correct machine attachment and pinch settings must be used. Edges must be bevelled. Do not position on uneven surface or seam allowance. Must be attached through more than one layer of cloth. Stitched poppers MUST BE machine attached.	
Drawcords Must be stitched from two or more	The Children's Clothing (Hood Cords)

pieces (unless inserted and extending from the side seam).
Inserted into suitable channels.
Garments with a chest measurement of <22cm flat must follow:

clothing. Cords and drawstrings on children's

Fusing Suitable weight and colour for bulk fabric. Do not use paper fusing. Accurate heat setting must be used to apply. Delamination is not acceptable. Use to support trims such as poppers or cloths such as boucle. Knitted fusing must be used for stretch cloths.	
Sleeve Head Roll and Shoulder Pads To be used on all tailored coats and jackets. Must be correct size for garment. Sleeve Head Roll: Edges must not be visible through outer. Shoulder Pad: Foot stitched at armhole and tacked at shoulder seam. Seam allowance must be trimmed.	
Rib Qualities Must have suitable residual extension.	
Elastic Suitable modulus based on the end use of the product. Pre-shrunk before attachment.	
Embroidery and Applique Must be neat. Puckering will be rejected in bulk.	Bite Me
Printing and Flocking Correctly registered without shadows. Minimal migration of flocking.

Quilting or Wadding Suitably encased to prevent migration	
Feathers Must not be live plucked, in line with EU law. Fibre composition must be listed on care label ie 70% feathers, 30% down	http://www.edfa.eu/en/homepage.html
