Five ways we change lives

Every 11 minutes, another family in Britain is made homeless. Every year, thousands come to us for help. And we do that in five crucial ways:

- We run a free national helpline open all year round
- We provide practical housing advice online
- We run face-to-face advice and specialist support services up and down the country
- Our team of solicitors attend court to represent ordinary people facing homelessness
- And we campaign to tackle the root causes of the housing crisis so that, one day, no one will need our help

Answering the call

Sarah had always paid her mortgage. But when she was made redundant from her job of eight years, things began to spiral out of control.

Sarah was anxious about losing the family home she shared with her disabled mother and five-year-old daughter. So anxious that she developed an agonising case of shingles.

But then Sarah called us. We helped her fight the eviction notice in court, and made sure she kept her home.

Youth group activities

Draw, build, talk

Ask the children to sketch their own home and discuss what they love about it. Explain why it's important to have a stable, warm, comfortable home. Then draw unusual homes, such as Noah's Ark, a nomadic tent or an igloo – you could even auction these pictures after your next service.
