
### Methodology

- Populus interviewed 2,004 GB adults (18+) online between 24 and 26 October 2014. Results have been weighted to be demographically representative of all British adults.
- Of these 2,004 GB adults, 515 were parents of 0-18 year olds. This report focuses only on these parents.
- Populus conducted similar research in October 2013, and tracking data is shown where appropriate.
- Where results do not sum to 100% this may be due to rounding, multiple choice categories or the exclusion of don't knows. Populus is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules. For more information see www.populus.co.uk.

Which three of the following would make you feel that the outlook for your children is improving?








# Young people's housing prospects is a particular concern among parents not feeling the economic recovery

Which three of the following would make you feel that the outlook for your children is improving?



Do you think the following issues have improved or worsened for young people in the last few years?








# More than any other issue, parents think home ownership prospects have worsened in recent years

Do you think the following issues have improved or worsened for young people in the last few years?



Do you think the following issues have improved or worsened for young people in the last few years?






## Anxiety about housing especially high among those not feeling the recovery
