

Make your own jute Christmas tree



1) Roll a piece of A4 card around itself to make a cone and stick in place with tape.

2) Trim to make a level base.



3) Apply glue to a small area of the cone all around and start to wrap the jute around, making sure you keep the jute tight together.

4) Keep wrapping the jute around, your cone, gluing down as you go down to the bottom. Trim when you get to the end.



5) Next in the same manner complete the top section and pin top to hold in place.

The glue will dry clear, but try to wipe off excess glue as you go.



6) With a small blob of glue add sequins as desired all around.

7) Taking a natural star, apply glue to the side.

Place sequins neatly like shown, repeat until you have 3 stars. Once dry for the finishing touch glue the stars to the top of your tree to sparkle away.

You will need:

Jute JF027/NAT, Glue HT1788, Stars C1701
Sequins CF0140502, A4 Card, Cellotape, Scissors
