#### Investing in our people



- Belong is a Gold Investor in People - an accolade which puts it in the top 15% of organisations
- By April 2023, the minimum hourly rate of pay in Belong had increased to £10.90. This took all colleague remuneration to the new Real Living Wage
- **24,125 training courses** were provided to Belong colleagues in the year
- We relaunched the Belong Champion Awards to recognise our people



#### Investing in our services

- We opened our first intergenerational care village in Chester
- We launched B's Dementia Café across all locations
- We launched the Tomforte residents' choir at Belong Morris Feinmann
- We hosted the Queen's Baton relay at Belong Newcastleunder-Lyme
- We continued to invest in the future through the ongoing development of Belong Birkdale, the launch of innovation groups and through our research partnerships
- We strengthened the **exercise provision** at all locations
