MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

Program Overview

The Mentorship Program pairs students at the point of graduation with professional software engineers and software engineer managers to help them navigate the tech industry and support them post-graduation. The mentor-mentee pair is encouraged to work together to mold the relationship to best suit their needs.

What is Hack Reactor and Telegraph Track?

Hack Reactor is an advanced software engineering immersive. Over the past 9 years, we've proven ourselves to be the top coding bootcamp, based on employer satisfaction and reported outcomes.

Telegraph Track is Hack Reactor's community of minority engineers from underrepresented backgrounds, including women or nonbinary people, people of color, LGBTQIA+, disabled people, immigrants, first-generation students, veterans, and students over age 40.

We provide these engineers with an extra layer of non-technical support through mentorship, additional career training, and networking opportunities with company representatives who are interested in building diverse workplaces.

Key Responsibilities & Time Commitment

- Connect with your mentee either in person or over Zoom at least 4 times after being matched (4 hours). We recommend meeting once every 1-2 weeks.

Mentor Eligibility

- Must be currently employed as a software engineer or software engineering manager
- No geographic restriction
- Does not have to be a Hack Reactor alum
- Does not have to be from an underrepresented group
- Must be able to make the full time commitment
- Must submit the mentor form

How do we choose mentors?

Mentors are chosen on a 'match-fit' basis. After reviewing your form, our team will assess how well you match with our current students. A 'match' is based on a number of factors, including but not limited to: socio-economic background, education prior to Hack Reactor, post-Hack Reactor career trajectory, technical interests, gender, ethnicity, etc. You can also indicate on your survey what you would like us to prioritize when matching.

If you are **not** chosen as a mentor, we will keep your application in consideration for the next round and your application will be considered first for the next round of mentorship opportunities.
