POSITION SUMMARY: Responsible for creating and maintaining a safe and secure environment at all Watermark campuses and events. Areas of responsibility include security strategy, policies & procedures, incident response, team leadership, and administration.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Strategy
 - a. Design and implement security strategy in coordination with the Director of Facilities Services and the vision of Watermark leadership
 - i. Scope includes Watermark facilities, services, and events, as well as offsite activities (e.g. international discipleship trips)
 - b. Develop and maintain policies and procedures
 - c. Keep up-to-date with various security threats and trends
- 2. Response
 - a. Serve as Church Incident Command
 - i. Must have taken ICS 100, 200, 300, 400, 700 and 800, or take them within the first 12 months of employment
 - 1. CIC responsibilities may be shared with other campus security staff as appropriate
 - b. Available 24/7 to respond to security and safety incidents as needed (coverage includes some evenings, weekend services, and holiday events as needed)
 - c. Communicate incidents and response to Watermark leadership

3. Team

- a. Overall security and safety leader through oversight of security staff, officers, and volunteers across all campuses
- b. Directly manage Security Coordinator; dotted line to other campus Facility & Security coordinators
- c. Manage in-house security officers and Gatekeepers
- d. Relationship manager with any outsourced security guards and/or police officers
- e. Recruit, train, develop, and manage volunteer Safety / Medical Team (SMT)
- f. Design and implement training protocols for staff, officers, and volunteers
- g. Should have experience in active shooter training and prefer instructor status
- h. Primary liaison with broader Watermark Staff on security & safety related policies, incidents, communications, etc.
- i. Other duties as assigned by Director of Facilities Services
- 4. Facilities & Equipment
 - a. Ensure function, supply, and compliance of core life safety systems (e.g. fire pump, extinguishers, generators, AED, etc.), security equipment (e.g. radios, cameras, etc.), and supplies (e.g. medical)
 - b. Manage access control (e.g. security fobs, key distribution & retention, master key list, etc.)
 - c. Interface with security-related vendors to select, install, maintain, and upgrade systems and equipment as needed for current and future facilities

MARKERS OF AN IDEAL CANDIDATE:

- Extensive knowledge and experience in the security and safety field
 - o Preferable 5 or more years of law enforcement, military security experience, or the equivalent in the private security sector
- Must be able to demonstrate appropriate supervisory experience
- Licensed Security Manager (or eligible to obtain the security manager license)
- Knowledge of both physical security and technical security is preferred (cameras, access control systems, alarm systems, etc.)
- Excellent leadership, communication, and administration skills
