




The Calgary Stampede is a notfor-profit community organization governed by a volunteer Board of Directors.



OH **R**anch




- Located west of Longview, AB

- You can visit the ranch during Alberta Open Farm Days in August each year




Stampede Ranch

- Born to Buck Program created in 1961
- Maximum times a Stampede bucking horse will compete each year – 10 to 15
- Roughly 500 horses call the Stampede Ranch home
- Approximately 200 actively compete in rodeos throughout the year
- Located near Hanna, AB










