Please provide our office a copy of the notice after publication in at least one newspaper of general circulation for the project area.

Also enclosed is a copy of the Federal signature page from the FEA, making it a Federal document. Please ensure that this page is inserted into the FEA before the FONSI is attached to it and made available for public review.
