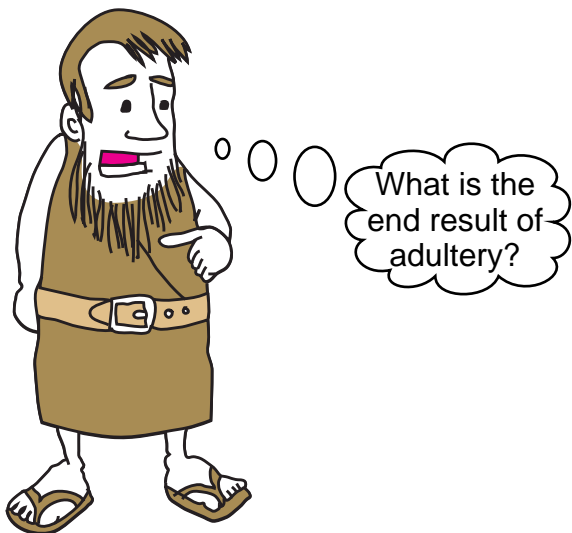
Is occasional

*Matthew 19:8-9*


What will happen to

heaven will get in.*

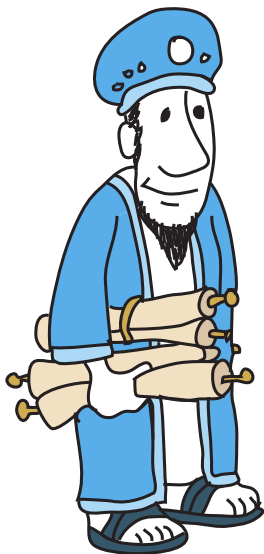

my heart pure?



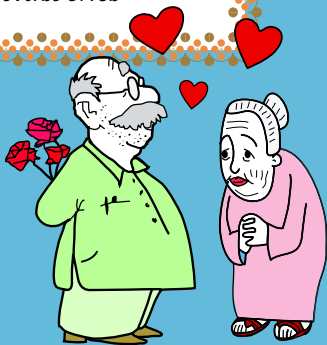
