Q: What is the end result of adultery?


A: He who commits adultery lacks sense; he who does it destroys himself. He will get wounds and dishonour, and his disgrace will not be wiped away. (Writings of the Prophets, Proverbs 6:32-33)


- Q: Is occasional adultery OK?

Q: Is occasional adultery OK?








Q: What will happen to those Christians who commitimmorality?




Q: Can a man divorce his wife for any reason?


Q: Why does it say in the Torah that a man can write out divorce papers and send his wife away?


Q: Is it alright to look at pornography on the internet, in magazines and films, etc?
