

**Subject:** Publication Issues

Dear Richard

I have been discussing publication issues with Ian, and would appreciate your thoughts on the following:

- We postpone the annual publication and bimonthly publication due on 18 November
  - As in our publication policy, we ask the police etc to review what we publish in light of whatever comes out of the joint security taskforce
  - You and Ian write to all MPs to announce this, offer condolences, commit to our ongoing collaboration on their security etc (I suggest after the debates this afternoon in case anything IPSA related comes out of it)
  - We remove access to the old stuff temporarily (although we know it is on other sites – it's a symbolic move really)
  - We consider whether to not publish anything until we are in a position (February?) to enact all the changes that are currently in the Board paper and the security related ones, and then restart regular publication in April OR we do some tweaks and publish in January etc (I don't think the latter makes much sense tbh)
  - No data that should be published will not be published eventually, just in a timeframe that allows us to get things right
  - I will rewrite the Board paper accordingly
