Hackney carriage fares are governed by a table of fares set by the local authority. They do not apply to private hire cars.

Ring and Ride



Ring and Ride provides a door to door minibus service for people who find it very difficult to use ordinary public transport. It operates short local journeys up to six miles seven days a week between 8am and 10.45pm Monday to Saturday and 8am and 10.25pm on Sundays.

You can use your Travel Vouchers on all Ring and Ride services but you will be charged the full fare because you have already bought your vouchers at a discount.

All vehicles are fully accessible, with low steps, wheelchair friendly tail-lifts and professionally trained drivers who will assist you to travel in comfort and safety.

Miles of Smiles 0161 622 2090

Available to Tameside residents who need to attend health and wellbeing related appointments but are unable to access public transport or the non emergency ambulance service.

Managed by Action Together CIO, the service is provided by a team of volunteers using their own vehicles. A charge is made to cover volunteers' expenses and there is an annual membership fee.

An accessible vehicle is available for wheelchair users.

Operates: Monday to Friday between 9am and 5pm. Registration: All passengers need to be registered.

HMR Circle (Heywood, Middleton and Rochdale circle) Volunteer Driver Service

Service provided by volunteers for older people and vulnerable adults who may have difficulty travelling on ordinary public transport.

The office can be contacted 9am to 4pm, Monday to Friday to discuss the scheme, opportunities to volunteer or take bookings for transport. Volunteer drivers are compensated directly by the passenger at 45p per mile. The service is operated mainly by volunteers using their own vehicles. A membership fee is payable of £20 per year. Travel Vouchers are not accepted by the volunteer drivers.

Transport for Sick Children (Greater Manchester)

Voluntary transport for sick children for journeys to and from hospitals, clinics and outpatients. Children must be under 16 years of age and be accompanied by a responsible adult. Seven days notice is preferred.

Shopmobility

Shopmobility hires out wheelchairs and scooters for disabled people. It is a voluntary association which relies on donations. You have to be a member to use the service which means completing a registration form and showing some proof of identification. There may be a small membership charge.
