We will start the securities transfer for you as soon as we receive the signed document. We will contact the back office of your current bank. Depending on the securities to be transferred and the response speed of your current bank or broker, the transfer may take a few (2 to 4) weeks

Terms and conditions for refunding transfer charges

Send us a summary of the incurred transfer charges within 6 months of the start of the securities transfer to your Keytrade Bank account. Please use the 'Securities transfer – Proof of charges' document and add a copy of the account statements with transfer charges.

1. Transfer charges can be refunded if:

· you can buy the security online on the Keytrade Bank website and

• the value of the transferred line is at least €500 (or the equivalent of €500 if the security is quoted in a different currency).

The charges for transferring securities that cannot be bought online with Keytrade Bank (securities that can only be sold online or that are traded by telephone, for example) or for which the value of the transferred line is lower than €500 (or the equivalent in a different currency) are not eligible for refund.

• 2. The maximum refund for transfer charges is €2,500 per calendar year per legal place residence. The refund is paid into your Keytrade Bank custody account. If you perform several transfers within 12 months, the €2,500 maximum applies to all transfers together.

Are you transferring funds¹?

Do the securities you wish to transfer to Keytrade Bank include any (listed or unlisted) funds?

We advise you to communicate us the receipts of purchase for transactions in funds that are (partially) invested in funds.

Why is this so important?

If you want to sell one of these funds in the future and Keytrade Bank does not have the exact date of purchase, Keytrade Bank will be obliged in the context of the capital gain tax in case of redemption to use the by law imposed fictive purchase date for the calculation of this tax. There is a chance that at the time of the sale you will be taxed on a 'fictitious' capital gain that is higher than what you actually received.

^{1 -} Fund means «Undertaking for collective Investment». Undertaking for collective Investment is a general term used for different undertakings collecting money from the public and whose activity consists in managing an investment portfolio. The fund notion contains as well collective investment schemes in the form of an investment company (such as the Sicav or Sicafi) as the contractual funds (such as the Mutual Fund) and their sub-funds.
