- We reduce face-to-face interactions whenever possible.
- Our caregivers always wear medical-grade masks while in the hospital.
 Patients will be given masks to wear in pre-surgery and surgical recovery areas. Employees may wear additional personal protective equipment in certain situations.
- We are limiting the number of visitors.
- Our facilities and equipment receive regular deep cleaning.
- High-tech disinfecting robots are used to help ensure hospital rooms and surgical areas are thoroughly clean.
