Day 2

Day 3

(2 nights on board and 3 nights in Caen)

Day 1 Monday: Portsmouth

Check-in at Portsmouth ferry terminal at approximately 21 h 30.

Departure from Portsmouth at 23 h 00.

Night on board in a 4-berth inside cabin.

Tuesday: Ouistreham – Côte Fleurie - Caen

Arriving in Ouistreham at 06 h 45.

Meet your driver and your English speaking guide. They will be with you all the way!

Transfer to the Gondrée café, near Pegasus Bridge. It was the first house liberated from France by British soldiers. Your guide will meet you at this place of pilgrimage. Throughout the day, you will discover the "Côte Fleurie".

Visit to the famous Poterie du Mesnil de Bavent workshops.

Stop off in the seaside resort of Cabourg and walk along the Promenade Marcel Proust

then a visit to the charming "La Villa Retrouvée museum", which tells the story of the Belle Époque.

Lunch in Villers-sur-Mer or Trouville-sur-Mer (small fishing port).

In the afternoon, visit to the **Manoir d'Apreval**, located between Deauville and Honfleur, a distillery and family estate. Passage through Honfleur, a must-see on the Côte Fleurie, guided tour.

Transfer to your hotel in Caen for dinner.

Overnight at the hotel.

Wednesday: Caen - Pont-Audemer - Jumièges - Cormeilles - Caen

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today **explore the little Venice of Normandy, Pont-Audemer**. Stroll through the medieval streets and **visit the church of Saint-Ouen**.

Visit Jumièges Abbey, nicknamed the most beautiful ruin in France.

Continue on to Cormeilles, lunch and a visit to this pretty village (many antique shops).

Then visit the Busnel distillery, the oldest in Normandy.

Optional: Afternoon tea at Belle Isle sur Risle optional.

Return to Caen for the evening, finishing by a dinner at your leisure.

Overnight at the hotel.

# Thursday: Caen - Pays D'Auge - Pont-L'Évêque - Lisieux

Day 4

### Breakfast at the hotel.

Travel through the **Pays D'Auge and visit Pont-L'Évêque**. **Stop for a gourmet break** at a cheese dairy for an interactive visit to the Calvados Experience with tastings of three Calvados.

Departure for **Lisieux**, one of the oldest towns in Normandy. Lunch.

Guided tour of the town and entrance to the **Basilica of St Thérese de Lisieux**, the second most important place of pilgrimage in France.

On the way back to Caen, visit the gardens of the **Château de St Germain** de Livet, nicknamed the wonder of the Pays d'Auge. A veritable architectural nugget nestling in the hollow of a valley in the heart of the Normandy countryside.

Return to Caen for the evening, finishing by a dinner at your leisure.

Overnight at your hotel.

# Friday: Caen - Ouistreham

#### Breakfast at the hotel.

On your last day in Normandy, you will have **free time** in the city of Caen.

After lunch, you will meet your guide and driver for your transfer to Ouistreham.

Check-in at Caen/Ouistreham ferry terminal at 15 h 00.

Departure from Caen/Ouistreham at 16 h 30.

Arriving in Portsmouth at 21 h 30.
