- What are you still wondering about after looking at the comic strip?



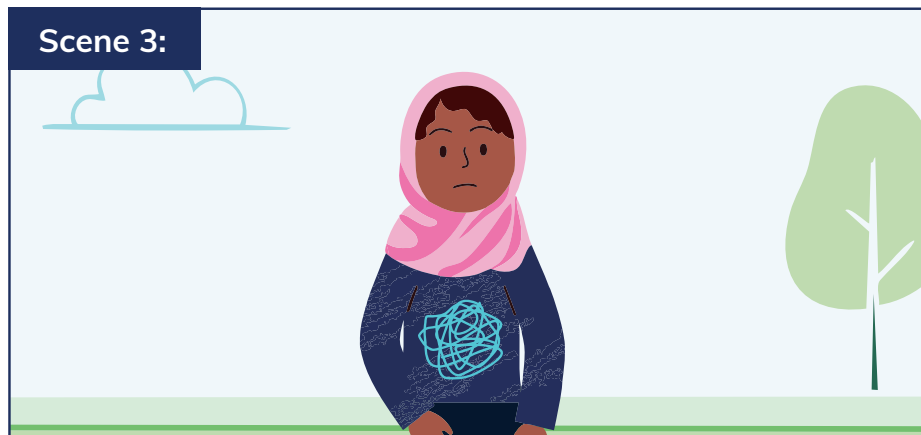
Sana's Scenario
