Visit a restaurant and pay for another table's meal. (You could also call a restaurant and pay for someone's to-go order.)
Choose a family to babysit their kids for free.
Send 3 text messages to friends you haven't heard from in awhile. Share an encouraging note, Bible verse, or prayer with them.
Create homemade cards to give to the residents at a local nursing home.
Bake cookies for a neighbor (or multiple neighbors!) and include a note of encouragement.
Buy a dozen or two of flowers, then tie a note of thanks or Bible verse around each stem. Pick a local hospital or doctor's office to drop the flowers off as an encouragement
to the nurses.
Find a widow to serve at their home doing yardwork or outside chores (like washing their car).
Tape a \$5 or \$10 bill on the gas tank for the next person that comes through.
Grab a sticky note pad and leave encouraging notes on places like your classmates' lockers or on your siblings door or your parents' bathroom mirror throughout the day.
Collect letters of appreciation from church members to give to a pastor or ministry leader.
Share a video of kindness on social media about something that you've seen a friend do. Tag that friend and encourage them to "pass the kindness" to someone else by
posting a story of kindness they've personally witnessed.
Pay for the person in front of you at the drive-thru.
Write a letter to your parents or grandparents sharing your favorite qualities about them.
Buy a gift card to give to a random stranger at the grocery store.
Volunteer to serve in the kids ministry at church twice this month. This could be on Sunday mornings or helping behind the scenes if your church is still meeting online-only.
