More than 50 larger-than-life, handmade mushrooms by Kara Kent and artists from Expo Design will capture the imaginations of all with their striking stature and funky colors.

The finale of a fog-filled evening must be Mischief Manor. Outside, visitors will meet The Three Graces and witness their attempt to keep the house in order while ghosts and spirits alike dance the night away in a party depicted with cutting-

edge projection mapping technology by Addy-award winning Lightborne Communication, Inc. The revitalized projection makes this year's show even more enthralling.
