## Fourth Edition of Artists Among Us Open Now

Newfields showcases the talents of employees in staff-only exhibition



**INDIANAPOLIS,** September 19, 2025 — Newfields celebrates the creativity of its team members with a new installation of a familiar exhibition, *Artists Among Us*, featuring 59 original works of art by employees. Season four of the exhibition is open now. The show remains an important opportunity for staff to showcase their passion and talent in a space open to every guest.

The exhibition presents an array of media and styles: an engaging selection of paintings, drawings, photographs, sculptures, textile arts and literary works representing a variety of stylistic approaches.

"The exhibitions in the Indianapolis Museum of Art and The Garden showcase remarkable works, but *Artists Among Us* is about celebrating the talent right here in our community," said Amanda Dietz Brooks, Director of Exhibitions. "We hope everyone can find a work in the show that feels familiar, personal or inspiring."

Although *Artists Among Us* is primarily an avenue to demonstrate staff appreciation, the Newfields team welcomes the community to participate in unique moments of inspiration and contemplation. Visitors are encouraged to explore the artwork and discover the voices behind Newfields' everyday operations.

This season of *Artists Among Us* will be on display on Floor One of the IMA until its closes on May 17, 2026. The exhibition is free and open to the public during museum hours.
