



## Endometrial Ablation Procedures

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### Policy

Oscar has traditionally denied coverage for many uterine ablation procedures based on clinical and/or reimbursement policy. Effective with the publication of this policy, Oscar will begin reimbursing for uterine ablation procedures when clinically appropriate, as it is in our members' best interest to have this technology available so they can access less invasive procedures with evidence supporting efficacy. It is also in the best interest to offer treatments that don't require hospitalization or prolonged recovery time, and that lower risk of complications.

### Reimbursement

Endometrial ablation procedures will only be reimbursed if both a CPT code and a diagnosis code from the lists below are included on the claim.
