For everyone, it's a chance to work on a website that will be visited by hundreds of thousands of people.

Role responsibilities and experience

Responsibilities:

- Help build components, pages, and features using React and Gatsby, and test them using Jest
- Collaborate with other members of the Digital team e.g. Design and also demo your work to Pride stakeholders from other teams
- Attend occasional meetings and workshops to help drive development decisions and determine next steps

You'll ace this if you:

- are self-motivated and take initiative to accomplish tasks
- are flexible working with technology that's potentially unfamiliar to you
- are accountable and dependable working in a volunteer project
- are interested in creating something awesome while gaining valuable experience.

Time commitment:

We'd estimate you'd spend about 4 to 8 hours a week on the project. We get together every other Saturday near Kings Cross, but you're free to work remotely as well.
