

IMPORTANT! Read all instructions before installing and using. Installer: This manual must be delivered to the end user.

Introduction

The 79STTRBZ integrates the functions of a stop/tail, turn and reverse light into one product. The product can be installed in either 7x9 or 9x7 orientation and will comly with FMVSS specifications for stop, tail, and turn. It is surface mounted, requiring no recesses to be cut for mounting, only mounting screw holes and a cable pass through hole. The wire leads provided should be tied to the vehicle circuits for stop, tail, turn, and reverse. Meets SAE J2040 & J2261 (vehicles > 80" wide) when properly configured


Meets SAE J585, J586 & J588 (vehicles < 80" wide) when properly configured








Installation & Mounting

- 1. Mark off and drill four 1/4" diameter mounting holes and a 1/2" wire hole on the vehicle mounting surface using the dimensions below. Verify that there is clearance behind the mounting surface before drilling.
- 2. Install customer supplied grommet in the 1/2" wire hole. Install the four supplied plastic grommets in the mounting holes.
- 3. Route the vehicle function wires and allow a minimum of 3" of slack to protrude from the wire hole.
- 4. Connect the vehicle wires to the product wires (by function) using waterproof connectors.
- 5. Verify operation and then push assembled electrical connectors through the wire hole and into the vehicle.
- 6. Mount the light housing to the vehicle using the four supplied #6 x 1-1/4" screws.
