

IICODE 3 Installation and Operation Instructions **Pattern Select Programmer**

Introduction:

The Pattern Select Programmer has been created to allow for easy and quick programming of Code 3's directional lights. The programmer has been designed to work with the MR6, Megathin, Chase, and M180 lighthead product families.

light head being programmed.

Operating Instructions

To program light head:

- 1. Connect power source to programmer.
 - a. Connect Ground to left terminal of Pattern Select Programmer.
 - b. Connect Positive to right terminal of Pattern Select Programmer.
- 2. Connect light head(s) to programmer.
 - a. Red wire from Programmer to Positive wire on light head(s).
 - b. Black wire from Programmer to Ground wire on light head(s).
 - c. Blue wire from Programmer to Program wire on light head(s).
- 3. Press "Start" button on the Pattern Select Programmer to set light head to last pattern when the unit is set to 0.
- 4. Otherwise rotate the "Knob" clockwise to select the pattern number you would like to choose. Then press the "Start" button. The unit will set the light head to the last pattern and then increment patterns until it gets to the pattern number you selected. Light head will remaining on for a few seconds showing the pattern selected.
- 5. To reset value back to zero press down on the "Knob". Then select the value you would like to program the light head to.
- 6. Press the "Demo" button to turn the light head on for a few seconds. This will allow you to see the pattern the light head is currently on.
