

# Rise Safeguarding Guide

To stay safe online and keep others safe around you, follow these tips:



## Look After Yourself

Contact the Rise Team if you ever feel unsafe or uncomfortable. Do not share private information, such as your location or contact information, with anyone online, and don't meet anyone in person who you've only interacted with online.

## Look After Others

Treat everyone you encounter with respect. Assume the best of everyone, demonstrating empathy without judgement or discrimination. Raise any concerns you have for others' safety and wellbeing.

## Demonstrate Integrity

Follow the application rules to create a fair and honest environment. Do not get assistance that could in any way constitute cheating. Do not disadvantage others by sharing information about the selection process.



## Be Informed

Read the Rise safeguarding information and make an effort to uphold the Rise Traits at all times.

## Participate Fully in Activities

Keep your camera on. Minimize any distractions. Keep your microphone muted unless speaking, and allow others to finish before you speak. Do not share your screen unless asked to do so. Do not record any Rise activities.

## Talk to the Rise Team

If you ever feel unsafe or uncomfortable in a Rise environment, contact our trained Designated Safeguarding Leads (DSLs). They will respond promptly and arrange a time to discuss your concerns further. The Rise DSLs are:
