

Girl Guides Matchday Mascot Prize Draw

Terms and Conditions

1. The prize draw is open to any UK resident aged 18 years or over who is the legal parent, guardian, or carer of an **“Eligible Child”** (meaning a child who is (i) aged 7-11 on the day of the Match (as defined below), (ii) registered as a Girl Guide, and (iii) a holder of a valid ticket to LCFC Women’s WSL home fixture against West Ham United FC Women (currently scheduled to kick-off at 11:55 (UK time) on 25 January 2026 at King Power Stadium) (the **“Match”**)), except employees of the Promoter, their families, agents or any third party directly associated with administration of the prize draw.
2. There is no additional cost to enter other than the standard cost of purchasing a Match ticket. Internet access is required.
3. The prize draw closes at 12pm (UK time) on 23 January 2026 (the **“Closing Date”**). Entries made after the Closing Date will not be valid and will not be entered into the prize draw.
4. To enter this prize draw, the Eligible Child’s parent, guardian or carer (the **“Entrant”**) must (i) access the online entry form (available at https://lcfc.formstack.com/forms/matchday_mascot_prize_draw_wsl_fixture_vs_west_ham_united), and (ii) complete all required fields in the online form, before the Closing Date detailed in condition 3 above. Only one entry is permitted per Eligible Child. Duplicate entries will not be valid and will not be included in the prize draw.
5. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for entries not successfully completed due to a technical fault, technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure of any kind. Entrants must provide a valid phone number and email address to claim the Prize.
6. One (1) winner will be selected by random draw performed by a computer process on 23 January 2026. The Promoter will check that each winner selected meets the eligibility criteria set out in these terms and conditions. If a winner does not meet the eligibility criteria, their entry will be deemed void, their Prize will be forfeited, and the Promoter will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above.
7. There is one (1) Prize to be won. The winner will receive one (1) matchday mascot opportunity for the Eligible Child to accompany an LCFC Women’s First Team

player during the pre-kick-off player entrance at the Match (the “Prize”). Please note:

- 7.1 the Prize may only be claimed by an eligible Entrant for use by an Eligible Child;
- 7.2 the relevant Eligible Child’s parent/legal guardian/carer must agree to allow the Eligible Child to participate as a matchday mascot at the Match in order to claim the Prize;
- 7.3 the Eligible Child must be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or carer who will be responsible for the Eligible Child at King Power Stadium before and after they have completed their role at the Match;
- 7.4 the Eligible Child and their parent/legal guardian/carer must be able to report to King Power Stadium at 9:15am (UK time) on 25 January 2026;
- 7.5 player allocations cannot be guaranteed; and
- 7.6 the Prize is subject to these terms and conditions, along with any other terms and conditions that apply to each of the items forming the Prize and that may be notified to each winner and/or the Eligible Child’s parent/legal guardian/carer by the Promoter.
8. The winner will be notified by email or telephone (using the details provided at entry) before 17:00 (UK time) on 23 January 2026, with details of how to claim their Prize. If a winner fails to respond to the Promoter by 17:00 (UK time) on 24 January 2026 or the relevant Eligible Child cannot attend the Match, then that winner's Prize will be forfeited and the Promoter reserves the right to select another winner in accordance with the process described above. The Promoter does not accept any responsibility or liability if you are unable to take up the Prize within the timescales set out in these terms and conditions.
9. There is a maximum of one Prize per person. The Prize is non-transferable, may not be exchanged for cash and is only valid for the Match (as detailed in condition 1).
10. Without limitation, no kit, tickets, travel, refreshments, or personal expenses are included in the Prize, and these must be paid for by the winner.
11. The decision of the Promoter regarding any aspect of the prize draw is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
12. The Promoter must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation, the Promoter will send the surname and county of the winner and, if applicable, a copy of their

winning entry, to anyone who emails juniorexperiences@lfc.co.uk within one (1) month after the Closing Date stated in condition 3. If you object to any or all of your surname, county and winning entry being published or made available please contact the Promoter by email to juniorexperiences@lfc.co.uk. In such circumstances, the Promoter must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

13. Entrants are deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions upon entry. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry, or to refuse to award the Prize, to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.
14. The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, cancel, suspend, or amend the Prize (or any item(s) forming part of the Prize) or the prize draw where it becomes necessary to do so or for administrative reasons without prior notice. Please note that the scheduling of the Match is subject to change, and should it be rescheduled to take place at a new time, date and/or location, the Prize may not be valid for the rearranged fixture. The Promoter reserves the right to replace the Prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond the Promoter's control make it necessary to do so.
15. Where the Promoter or any of its providers makes any changes to the Prize or the Match, no compensation or cash equivalent will be available (subject to the Promoter's right set out in condition 14). The Promoter will not be liable for any cancellations or changes to the prize draw or the Prize (in whole or in part), or for any loss or damage. Nothing in these terms shall exclude or limit the liability of the Promoter in relation to personal injury or death caused by the Promoter's negligence or for fraud.
16. Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate any winner(s) or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the Prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.
17. Personal data supplied during the course of this prize draw will be processed for the administration of this prize draw, for fulfilment of the Prize (where applicable) and in accordance with the Promoter's privacy policy available at lfc.com/terms. See also condition 12 with regard to the announcement of the winner.
18. This prize draw is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with, Instagram, Facebook, Threads, X (Twitter), LinkedIn and/or any

other social media platform, and such platforms shall have no liability to entrants.

19. The prize draw will be governed by English law and entrants to the prize draw submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
