

MAM Q3 TEACHER SUMMARY

VOCABULARY

Learning about Lines, Unity, Gestures, and GIFs develops students' artistic competencies and equips them with academic vocabulary to enhance their verbal and written communication.

CONCEPT DEVELOPMENT

Creating original ideas for artwork honors students' voices and provides supports that help students express themselves more clearly and fully.

ART-MAKING PROCESS

Sketching, revising, and creating artwork develops students' critical thinking skills and provides all students - regardless of their current abilities - opportunities to improve over the course of the unit.

GIF EXPLORATION

Use VTS or other discussion strategies to engage students in a conversation about art.

This activity provides students with the opportunity to respond to original works of art and to be introduced to the instructional unit.

VOCABULARY

Conduct the Expressive Lines activity to let students explore how lines impact works of art.

This activity gives students the knowledge they need to complete the assignment and eventually share their work using academic vocabulary.

BRAINSTORMING

Assign brainstorming worksheet which will lead students through the process of choosing a ritual and its gestures.

This activity lets students engage in divergent thinking while also providing them with a structured process for planning their artwork.

SKETCHING

Have students plan their GIF by creating rough compositions.

This activity allows students to review compositional techniques and to create more aesthetically advanced works of art.

5

PEER FEEDBACK

Have students offer each other feedback on their plan.

This activity gives students the opportunity to learn from peers and to make adjustments that will strengthen their artwork.

6

GIF MAKING

Demonstrate GIF making process and have students complete steps independently or with your guidance.

This activity provides students the opportunity to execute their plan and create artwork that is meaningful and relevant to their lives.

7

SHOWCASE

Display final GIFs and engage students in critique.

This activity lets students share their accomplishments and receive praise and constructive feedback from their instructors and peers.
