

INTRODUCING DISCOVER ABORIGINAL EXPERIENCES



Nowhere in the world can claim a cultural legacy quite like Aboriginal Australia. For at least 65,000 years, its peoples – with hundreds of distinct clans, and as many languages and dialects – have walked the continent, making Aboriginal cultures the oldest continuous living cultures on the planet. As travellers seek out greater authenticity and cultural engagement, interest in Indigenous tourism continues to grow. For the world's Indigenous communities, tourism is well and truly a powerful driver for positive change and the sustainability of cultures.

It was with this in mind that Tourism Australia launched Discover Aboriginal Experiences (DAE), a collective of 54 members representing more than 200 exceptional Aboriginal guided experiences across the country. Aboriginal guides don't just afford a unique means of bringing Australia's landscapes to life – as the owners of the stories they share, they offer a means of connecting with Australian places and cultures quite unlike anything else you'll find.

Each member in the portfolio is welcomed based on a stringent official selection process by peers, competitors and the industry at large, which means they are all world-class leaders in Aboriginal tourism, representing local Aboriginal cultures with integrity and authenticity. Every member holds a unique story, yet together they weave the vibrant tapestry of Discover Aboriginal Experiences, whether in urban areas or regional Australia, on Sea Country or the land. This creates a diverse portfolio of experiences covering everything from wildlife and nature-based activities to coastal and aquatic, food and drink, active adventures, immersive journeys, art and museums, and accommodation.

Discover Aboriginal Experiences is part of Tourism Australia's Signature Experiences of Australia program: a curated collection of seven partners covering exceptional experiences and attractions across the country that are diverse in nature – but united in an uncompromising commitment to excellence, the environment, people and place. Each marketing collective streamlines the decision-making process for discerning travellers, media and travel designers, with partners selecting some of the best of the best. The collection ensures that every offering not only meets the highest of standards, but also reflects Australia's most unique qualities, whether in location or special interest. Each partner, including Discover Aboriginal Experiences, acts as a central contact point not only for its members, but also for trade and media, offering a wide range of collateral and knowledge via information kits, imagery, videos and newsletters.

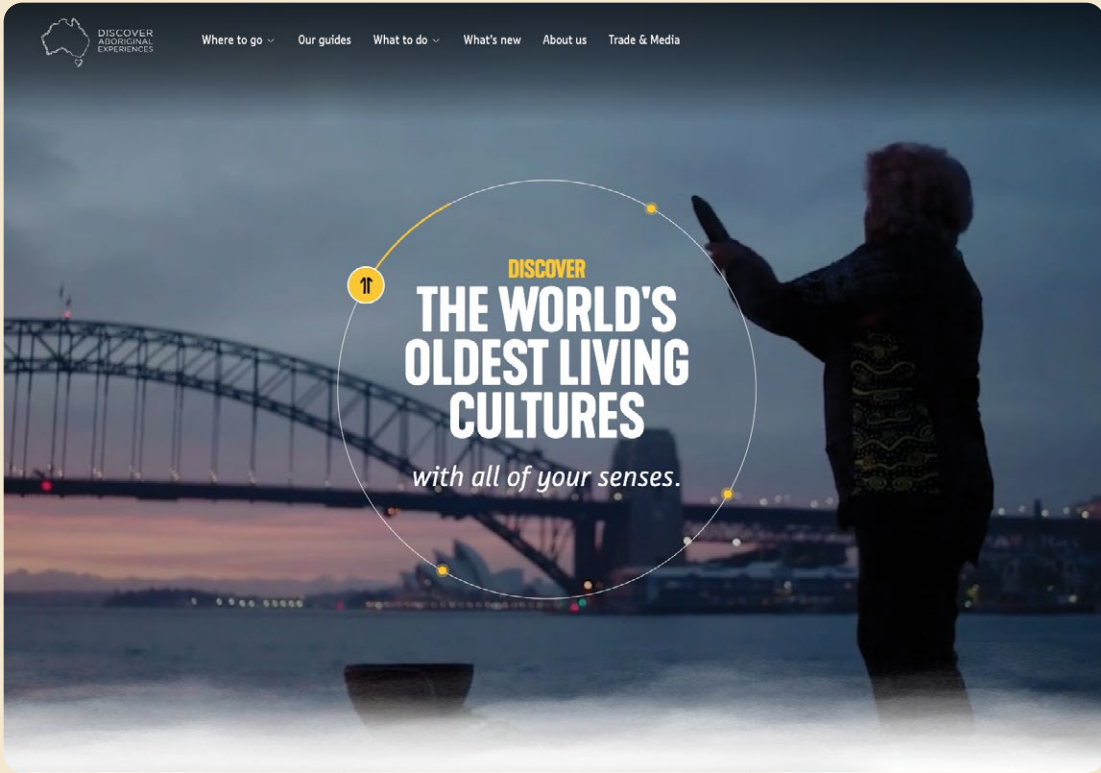

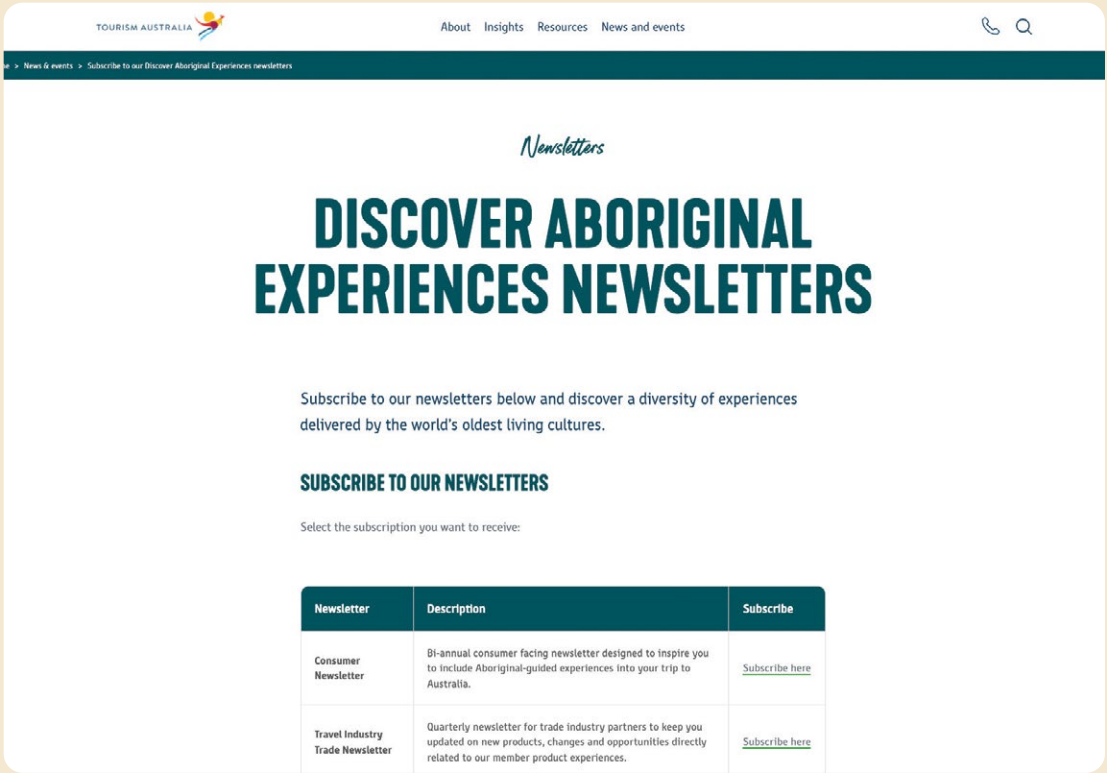


CONTENT

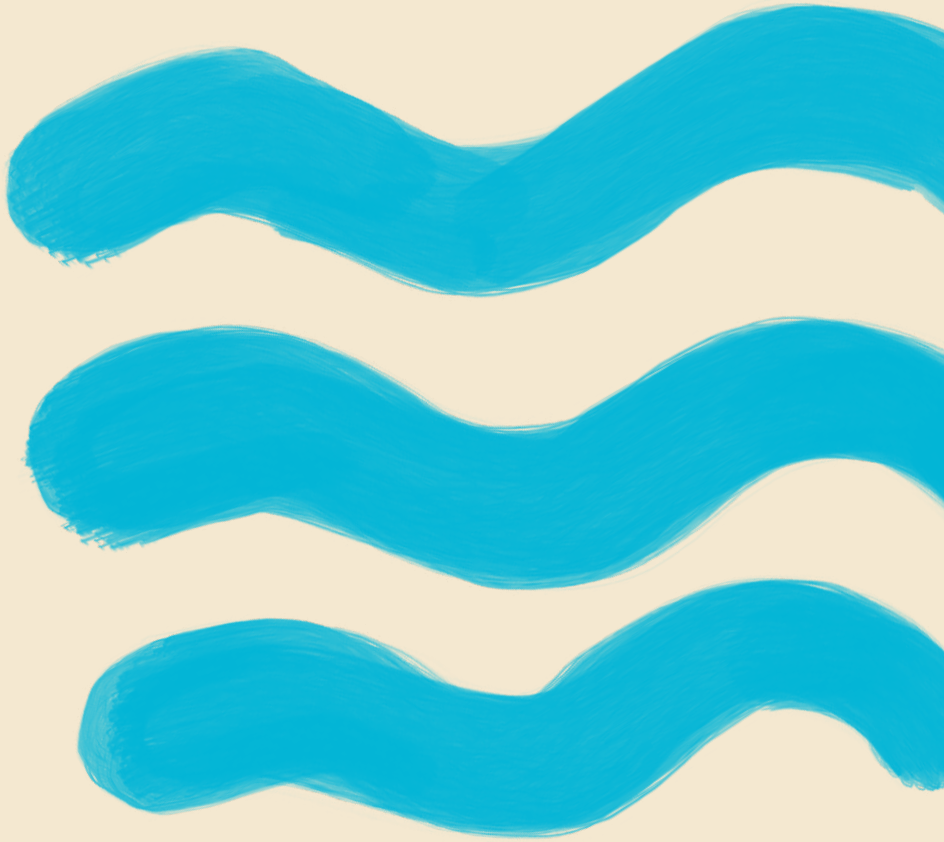
TOURISM AUSTRALIA INDIGENOUS GUIDELINES
