- Access trails at your own risk

- Stay on groomed trails, leave gates as you found them
- Do not litter
- Please observe social distancing recommendations at the trailhead and on trails
- Face coverings may be recommended.

TRAIL RULES

DOG ETIQUETTE

- Maintain control of your dog at all times
- Dogs must be leashed at all trailheads and for the first 200 yards of groomed trail in the National Forest
- To reduce conflict and crowding please only bring a maximum of 2 dogs per party
- Remove your dog's business by packing it out
No one enjoys brown snow
- Dogs are not allowed at Teton Reserve or Southern Valley
- Dog etiquette is especially important in Teton Canyon. This trail has seen a dramatic increase in use with multiple injuries due to skier and dog conflicts

SKI TRAIL GROOMING

- Snow conditions determine start and end of grooming season
- Grooming may be postponed at any time, or due to blizzard conditions
- See grooming schedule inside brochure, and visit our website for latest conditions
- Single-track trails are groomed as needed, not according to the Nordic grooming schedule





GROOMED TRAIL COURTESY



Yield trail to skiers. Walk on the edge of the groomed trail outside of the classic track. Footprints down the middle of the trail creates a hazard.



These are multi-use trails. Control your speed when approaching walkers, fat bikes and dogs.



Yield trail to walkers and skiers. Only ride on the groomed trail when the snow is firm.

IF YOU ARE LEAVING RUTS YOU ARE DAMAGING THE TRACK



Pick up your waste. Don't chase animals. Maintain self-control.
