Changes to the supplier-base are to be shared immediately

Instagrid principles and values are communicated to relevant sub-suppliers

A Supply Chain Due Diligence is established Environmental and social data are to be collected, monitored and shared



Waste management system is established

Plastic free solutions for packaging are offered

Permanent fixation of components is avoided

Input materials shall be minimized

Use of recycled materials shall be evaluated on a regular basis
