Impressive, in the most subtle expression of pure luxury. Inspired by Scandinavian design, a wave of seamless lines takes the eyes on a journey of innovation and craftsmanship.

Driven by a holistic approach to design CEBRA Architects conceptualizes Harbour House as "a visual echo of the surroundings". Kolja Neilsen, lead architect shares, "it is through this location and architectural execution, that the building will link nature, history and the heritage of this area to capture the feel of this unique site." Rising just 6 intimate storeys with 130 suites, the building's unique architectural style blends contemporary sophistication, with natural nuances of wood and stone. Sculptured balconies and rooftop terraces invite the inside out, while generous windows reflect the beauty all around.



The building's L-shape is composed of a series of vertical volumes that emerge with folded shapes along the façade creating a pleated design that is further articulated through sun and shadows. The pleated shape creates a distinct division which are highlighted by large rooftop terraces for penthouse units. The placement of large windows combined with inset balconies creates a simple, yet vivid expression of recessed and even openings, while the pleated shape of the facades and balcony design protects residents from winds and provides privacy.

At ground level discover an animated streetscape with retail and large display windows inviting a sense of light and transparency. The prominent entrance for the residential units welcomes with a warm glow from the use of wood, creating an almost Nordic feel to it.






NATURE'S GIFT



GEORGIAN TRAIL




SCENIC CAVES














CULTIVATED EXPERIENCES

CELEBRATING HISTORY

Collingwood has a colourful history shaped by the railways, ship building and agriculture. Originally known as Hurontario, Nottawa, and even Hensand-Chickens Harbour (as a reference to the small islands in the bay), the town was incorporated in 1854 and renamed in honour of Admiral Lord Cuthbert Collingwood - a British naval officer, and hero at the Battle of Trafalgar. In 1855, the Ontario, Simcoe & Huron Railway came into Collingwood, and the harbour became the place for shipment of goods destined for upper Great Lakes ports.



Explore the historic downtown to experience architectural styles of over 50 different heritage buildings, as well as landmarks including the Shipyards, Collingwood Terminals grain elevator, and the town hall. And for a fascinating history lesson, the Collingwood Museum has exhibits on the harbour's shipbuilding history among other local collections, while The Awen' Gathering Place along the waterfront invites opportunities to engage and learn about the First nations Indigenous people.
