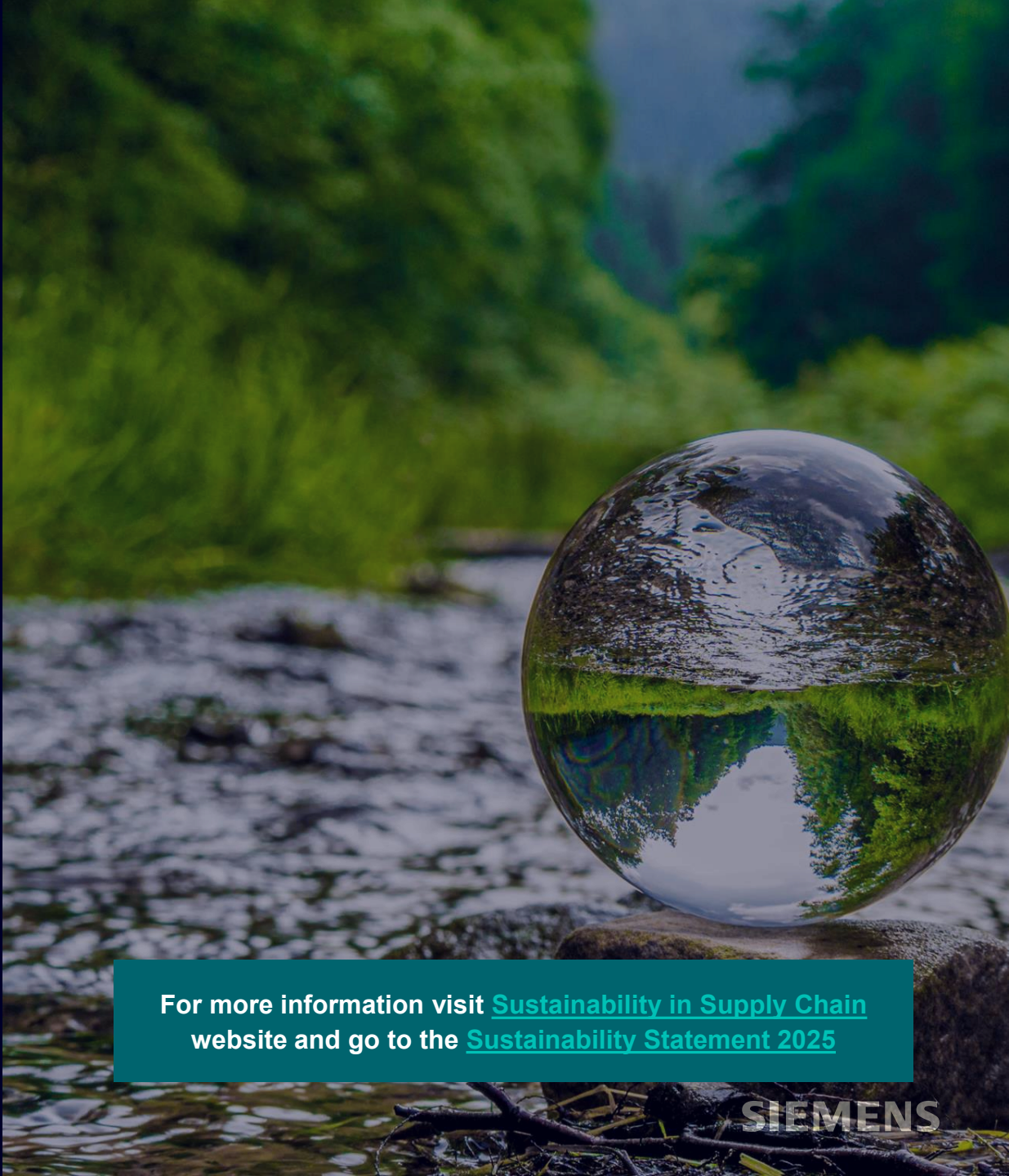

# Responsible Minerals Sourcing

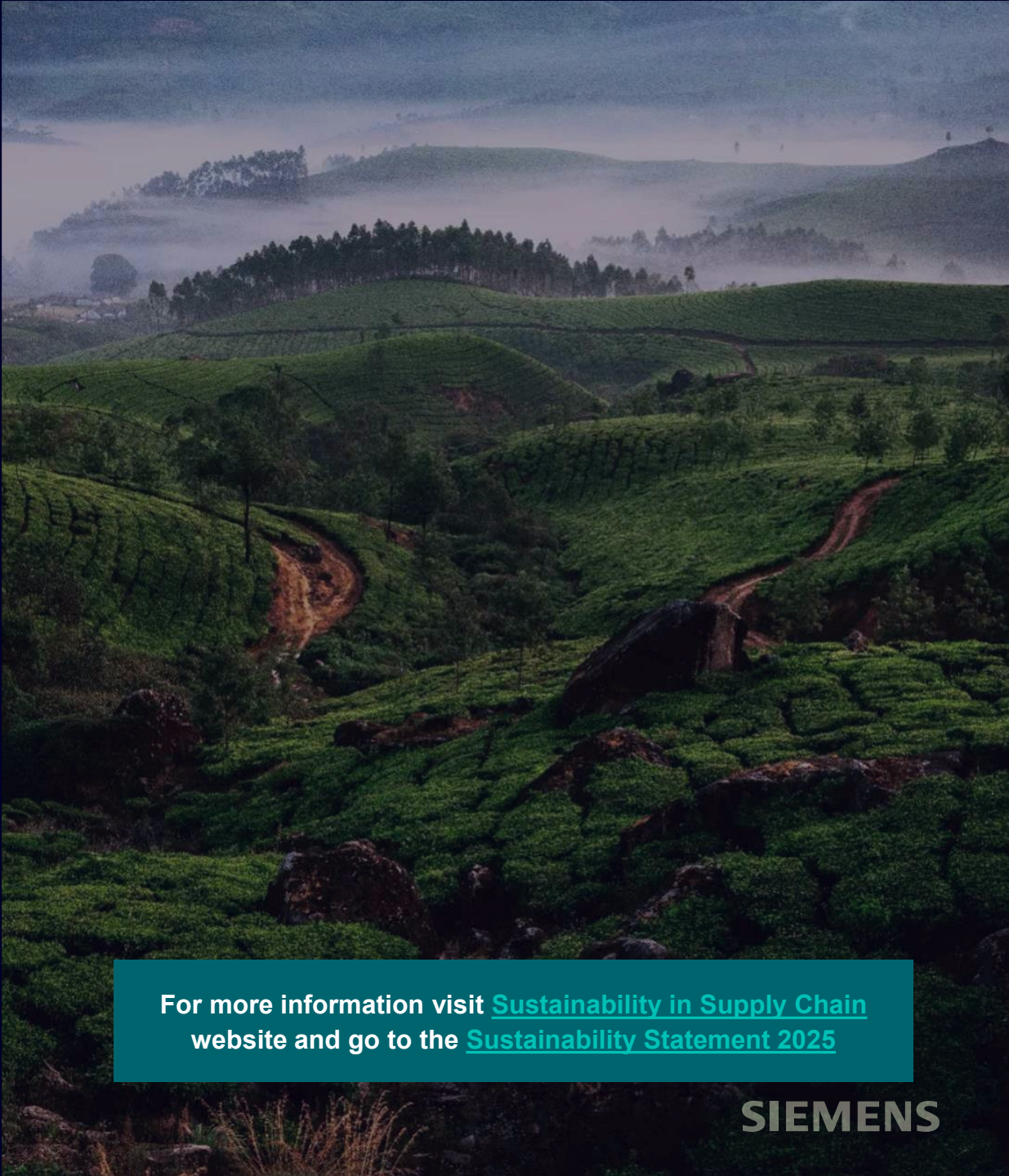
Responsible Minerals Sourcing (RMS) is a process preventing the incidence of conflict minerals in our supply chain to safeguard an ESG Secured Supply Chain. Responsible Sourcing of “3TG” (Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten, Gold), recently incl. Cobalt and Mica, aims to mitigate the risk that purchased goods may contain minerals from conflict regions, which contribute to human rights abuses, corruption and financing of armed groups.
