WHY TEMPLATE?



In an incredibly visually polluted environment, a lack of continuity across marketing collateral means that there is nothing for the casual observer to latch onto. They have to ask "What is that? Where is it? Is it a gig? A show?..."


By this time they have walked on and the opportunity to reach them has past.

Our poster template responds to this, taking an approach that pools resources across our community of practitioners, growing audiences for everyone over time.

It allows audiences the possibility of instant recognition.



We have 4 templated poster layouts that frame the promoted show within the show image. For every poster we keep this template the same so that it stays distinctively recognisable as Basement Theatre.



DATE

Dates are written in capitals and months should always be 3 letters, for example AUG for August, SEP for September, etc.

PRESENTED BY

Presented by is always written in upper & lower case and in bold.



Each season has it's own heading and this should not be altered.


SEASON**XX Company Presents****SHOW

The show title should always be written in capitals. Font size can be adjusted so that fits proportionately but please refrain from moving the headings to another position. (Use a different template if the title is not in the best position).

MAX HEIGHT

Make sure all lockup information fits within the inverted staircase graphic. Font size can be increased if you have less copy, but never reduced. If you have more copy please use 2 columns.

We have a palette of four colours per season that help identify each season. When selecting colours for your poster please limit this to three. Two for the frame and one for the show title and information.

THE FRAME

Use two contrasting seasonal colours.

TYPE ON IMAGE

Use any one colour from the Basement colour palette that best contrasts with the image.

For the frame, use 2 colours that contrast with each other so that the type has maximum legibility.

For the show title and information, pick a colour that contrasts the most with your image. This can be any of the Basement colours and not limited to the season. Only use 1 colour for both title and show information.


