



#### **Nominations for Council 2022**

#### **Voting Professional Members**

In accordance with section 2 of Bye-Law 4, the Council of The Institute of Bankers in Ireland ("IOB") hereby invites nominations from amongst the Voting Members of IOB for candidates for election to Council.

One (1) relevant Council seat will be vacant at the next Annual General Meeting ("AGM") in March 2022. Fellows, Licentiates and Practitioners (together the "Voting Members") are eligible to hold office as a Council member and are eligible to vote in such elections to Council.

Nominations for election must be in the form specified in the Schedule to Bye-Law 4 and must be signed by not less than six (6) Voting Members of IOB. Nominations must also include confirmation in writing from the nominee in the form specified in the Schedule of his or her willingness to become a member of Council.

Nominations must be lodged with the Secretary of IOB **not later than 5pm on 17 January 2022**.
