SAFETY MEASURES AND CUSTOMER EXPECTATIONS

Our #1 priority is keeping you safe. Below are the festival and on-course modifications we're making to ensure a safe, exciting event for everyone. Please review these guidelines carefully before your event.

HIGH-RISK INDIVIDUALS

High risk individuals, or anyone living with high risk individuals, are encouraged not to attend the event. High-risk individuals may include:

- Anyone over 65 years of age;
- People who have chronic lung disease, moderate to severe asthma and/or severe heart disease;
- People who are immunocompromised: those who have undergone or are undergoing cancer treatment, bone marrow or organ transplantation; anyone with immune deficiencies, poorly controlled HIV or AIDS, or had prolonged use of corticosteroids; and smokers;
- People of any age with class III or severe obesity; or
- Anyone diagnosed with the following underlying conditions: diabetes, liver disease and persons with chronic kidney disease undergoing dialysis.

Always refer to the latest governing body guidelines when deciding if you should attend.

PRE-RACE HEALTH MONITORING

Customers should monitor their health 14 days prior to race day, and be aware of any symptoms that could indicate they have been infected with the novel coronavirus. Any customer exhibiting the following symptoms in the 14 days prior to an event should not attend. This includes:

- Cough
- Shortness of Breath
- Labored Breathing
- Fever
- Chills
- Muscle Aches
- Sore Throat
- Loss of Taste or Smell

Individuals who have been in close contact for more than 15 minutes with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 or who exhibits the above symptoms in the last 14 days should not attend.

VENUE & COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

We are heading back to beautiful Mammoth Lakes Ski Resort for our tenth annual OCR World Championship event weekend. Deep within the Inyo National Forest, these courses are sure to leave you breathless from the beautiful views and wildlife they have to offer. The property provides opportunities for camping, hiking, mountain biking, and has a lively Village where you can find food and activities for all ages. With 40+ obstacles. 9+ miles of challenging terrain and 5 unique courses, be prepared for 1 ultimate race weekend.

We kindly ask that you respect this forest as you race and avoid littering of any kind. Aid stations will offer receptacles to dispose of any trash you may have.

Anything taken out with you on course must come back with you, aside from litter which can be disposed of at aid stations. Anyone caught littering or handing items to spectators will be disqualified immediately.

Special Gear: Racers should plan to bring appropriate fuel for their needs. Nutrition will be available on course. Hydration packs (or water containers of some variety) are strongly suggested for all racers. Please note that shoes with spikes are not allowed.

AID STATIONS

At each stop you will be able to drink as much water as you want, however we ask that you only take one (1) cup. All racers will have the ability to fill their hydration pack at the Start Line.

- 15k: There will be nine (9) aid stations on course, including one (1) hydration pack refilling stations
- **3k:** There will be two (2) aid stations on course with no on-course hydration pack refilling station.
- **6k Team Relay:** There will be three (3) aid stations on course with no on-course hydration pack refilling station.
- 5k Charity Race:There will be one (1) aid station on course with no on-course hydration pack refilling station.
- 100m: There will be one (1) aid station next to the course with no hydration pack refilling station.

Female Kits will be available at each aid station, if needed. Ask your aid station volunteer for assistance.







- Make sure to fill your pack up prior to the race.
- Make sure you carry enough water to be able to keep yourself hydrated between stations.
- Make sure to stop at every aid station to get water, use your pack in between.
- We highly suggest carrying some type of electrolyte drink in addition to water.
- Make sure to properly hydrate in the week leading up to the event. The altitude is no joke!

COURSE CUTOFFS

All courses/distances must be cleared by 6:00 pm each race day. Course cutoff for the 15k specifically will be announced soon.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

As always, weather can be unpredictable. Please come prepared for chilly morning and evening temperatures. If any severe weather happens, all staff and volunteers will direct you to safe zones. Please listen to their direction as they are there for the safety of the racers.

EQUIPMENT & CLOTHING

- All participants are encouraged to bring a change of clothes, shoes, and a plastic bag for wet and muddy items. Please plan your post-race gear accordingly.
- Hydration packs are strongly recommended for all racers.
- Shoes with spikes are not allowed.
- Our official merchandise tent will open at the same time as the festival area. Forget your racing shoes, change of clothes, spare socks? We can help.



It is the responsibility of each competitor to know and understand all competition rules and penalties. These rules serve as a common reference guide for all Competitors, Officials, and Volunteers. MANDATORY GEAR LIST

- Headlamp
- Water refill pack
- Bibs MUST be worn where they can be seen at all times
- 100% Completion wristbands must be easily accessible at all times by officials

ITEMS TO AVOID

- Shoes with spikes
- Hand chalk or other products that would leave residue on the obstacles
- No headphones are allowed on course (one ear in is ok)
- Littering! Any littering will result in an immediate disqualification

MOUNTAIN CONSIDERATIONS

Please be mindful of the Mountain as this is a part of the protected US Forest Service land.

- Do not litter!! Littering will result in an immediate disqualification.
- Do not touch any wildlife
- Do not disturb the vegetation/trees
- If you need to use the bathroom, please wait until you come across one of our many toilet stations to do your business. NATURE IS NOT YOUR BATHROOM here. There are plenty of toilet stops along the course.

*All volunteers must work a total of eight-hours and check out with the Volunteer Director to receive their free race entry. Volunteers that work a four-hour shift will receive a code for 50% off a race entry.
