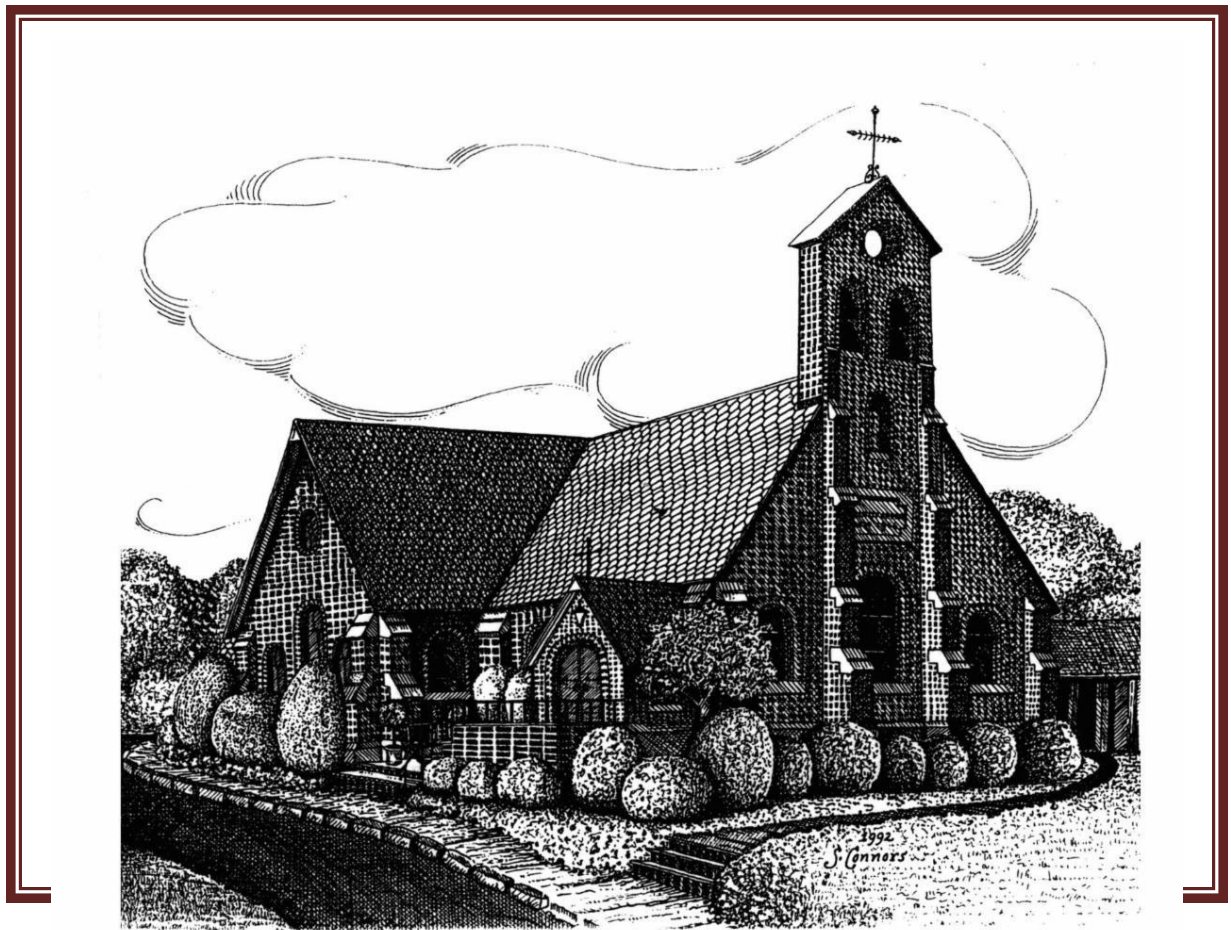

First Reading: Genesis 15:1-12, 17-18 Scripture Insert

All sit for the readings.

After the reading, the people respond as follows:

Reader The Word of the Lord.

People Thanks be to God.

Response: Psalm 27 Use chant insert, sung by all

Remain seated for the Response.

Second Reading: Philippians 3:17-4:1 Scripture Insert

All stand and remain standing after the hymn.

Sanctus Hymn - 455 O Love of God, how strong and true Hymnal

Holy Gospel: Luke 13:31-35 Scripture Insert

Celebrant The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke.

People Glory to you, Lord Christ.

After the Gospel is read, the people respond as follows:

Celebrant The Gospel of the Lord.

People Praise to you, Lord Christ.
