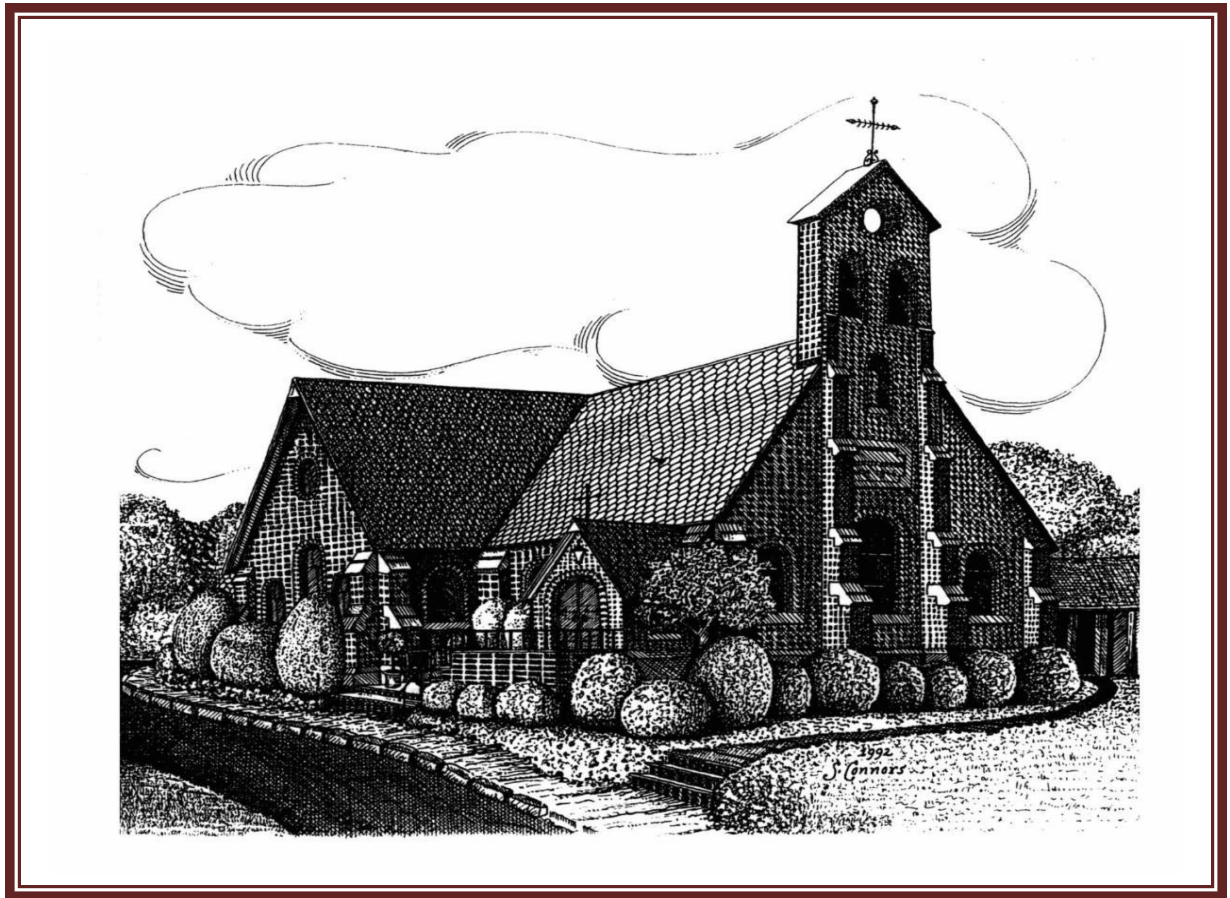

First Reading: Acts 7:55-60 Scripture Insert

All sit for the readings.

After the reading, the people respond as follows:

Reader The Word of the Lord.

People Thanks be to God.

Response: Psalm 31:1-5, 15-16 Scripture Insert

Remain seated for the Response.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 2:2-10 Scripture Insert

All stand and remain standing after the hymn.

Sequence Hymn - 536 Open your ears, o faithful people Hymnal

Holy Gospel: John 14:1-14

Scripture Insert

Celebrant The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John.

People Glory to you, Lord Christ.

After the Gospel is read, the people respond as follows:

Celebrant The Gospel of the Lord.

People Praise to you, Lord Christ.
