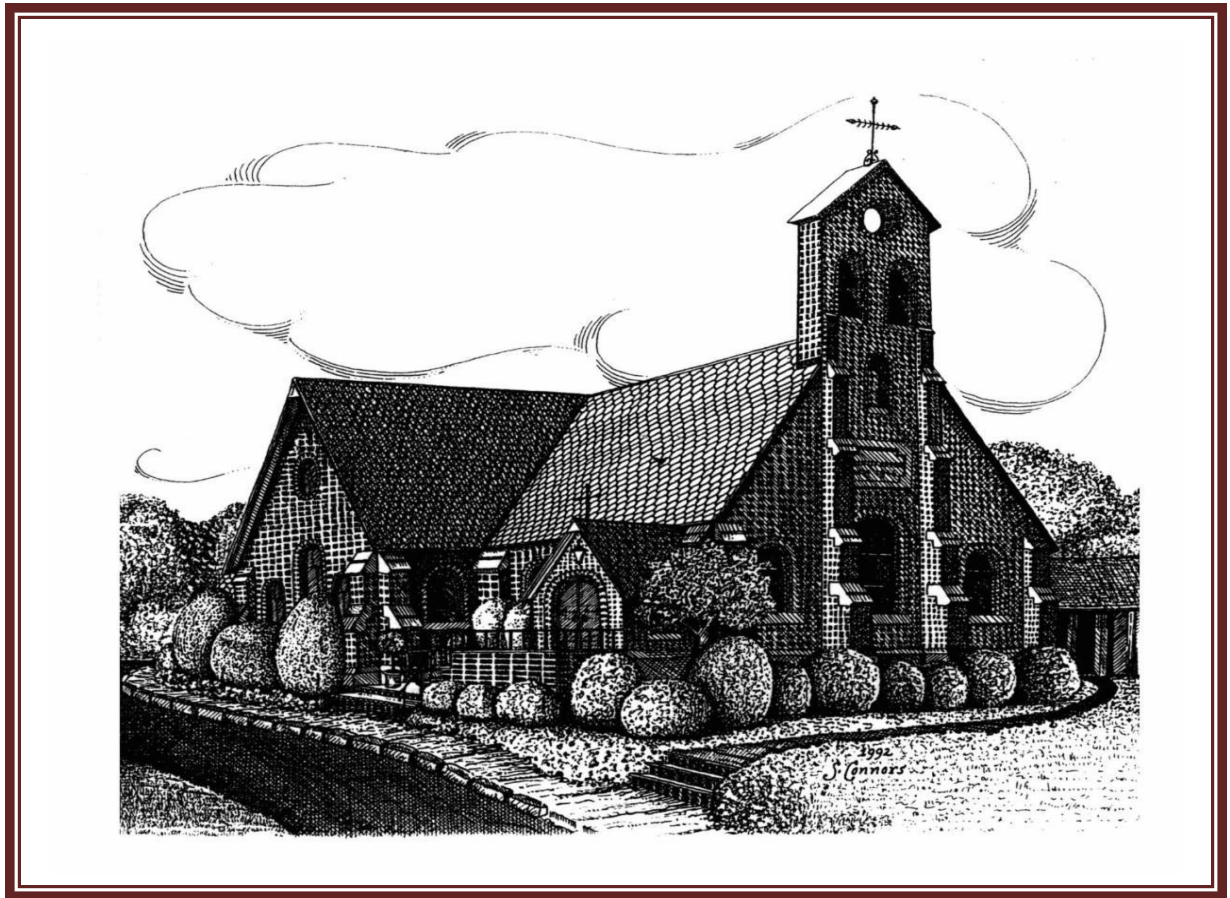

After the reading, the people respond as follows:

People Thanks be to God.

Response: Psalm 66:7-18 Scripture Insert

Remain seated for the Response.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 3:13-22 Scripture Insert

All stand and remain standing after the hymn.

Sequence Hymn - 651 This is my Father's world Hymnal

Holy Gospel: John 14:15-21

Scripture Insert

Celebrant The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John.

People Glory to you, Lord Christ.

After the Gospel is read, the people respond as follows:

Celebrant The Gospel of the Lord.

People Praise to you, Lord Christ.
