

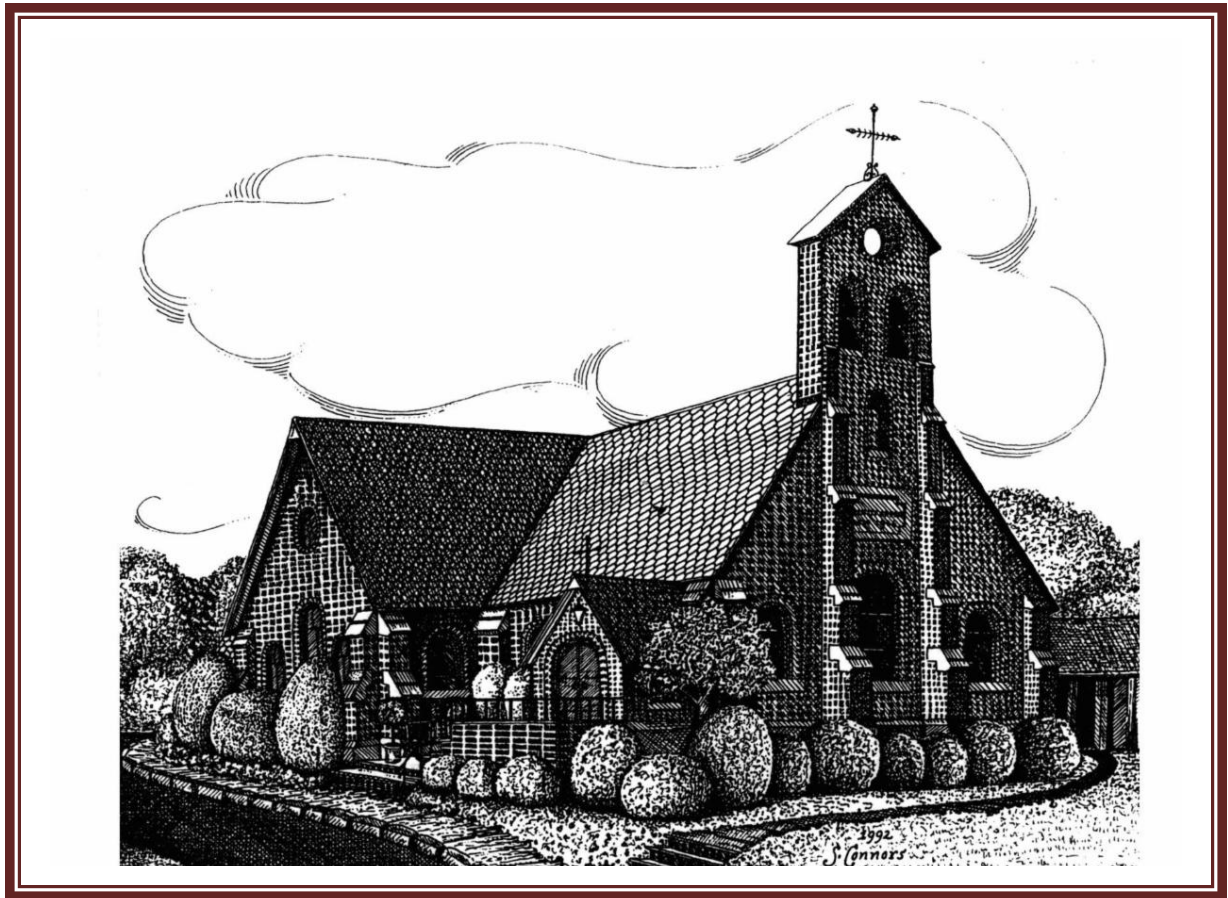

Remain seated for the Response.

All stand and remain standing after the hymn.

Holy Gospel: Mark 10:46-52

Scripture Insert

Celebrant The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Mark.

People Praise to you, Lord Christ.

Representatives of the congregation bring the people's offerings of bread and money or other gifts, to the celebrant. The people stand while the offerings are presented and placed on the Altar.
