

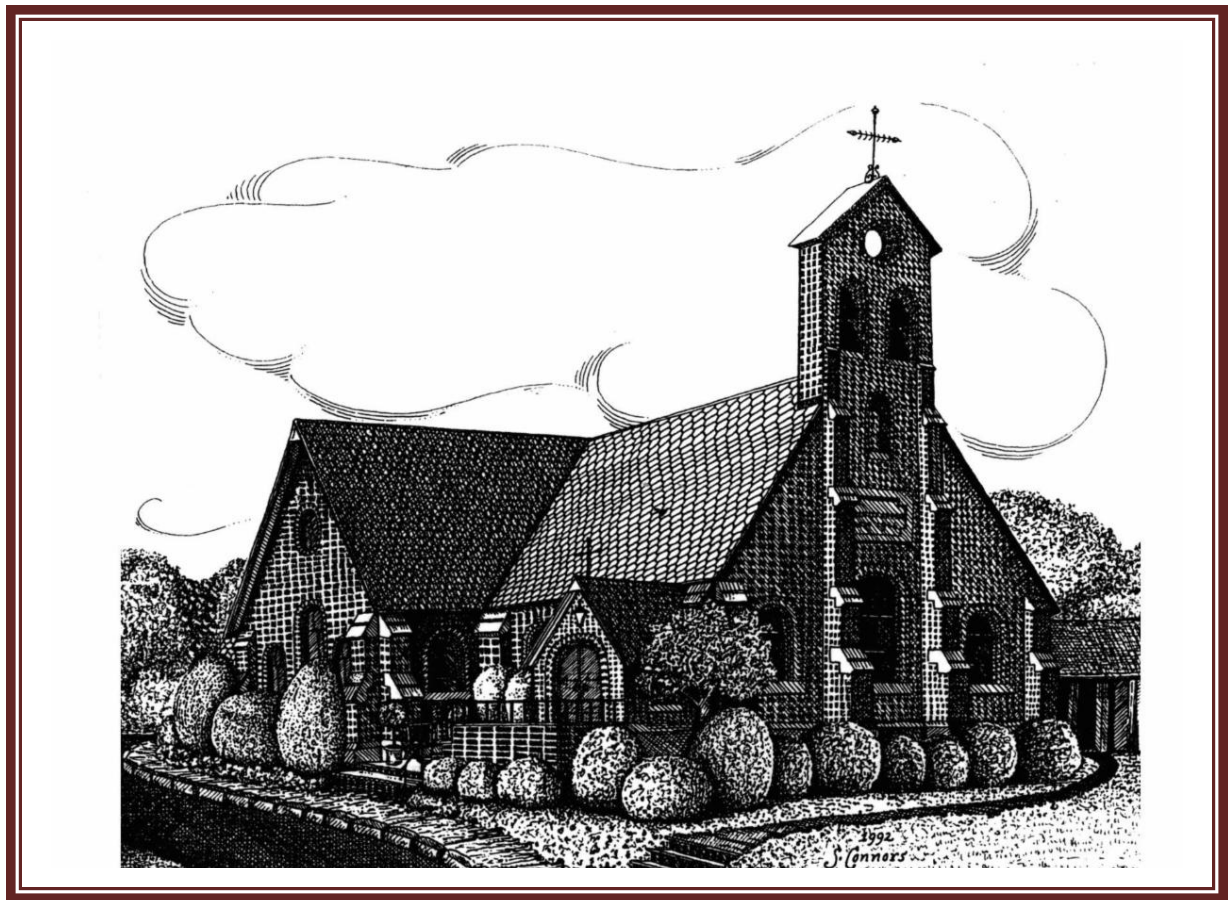

Celebrant The Lord be with you.

Celebrant Let us pray.

First Reading: Isaiah 50:4-9a

Scripture Insert

All sit for the readings.

After the reading, the people respond as follows:

Reader The Word of the Lord.

People Thanks be to God.

Psalm 31:9-16

Scripture Insert

Remain seated for the Response.

Second Reading: Philippians 2:5-11

Scripture Insert

After the reading, the people respond as follows:

Reader The Word of the Lord.

People Thanks be to God.

All stand.

Hymn - 435 At the Name of Jesus, every knee shall bow *Vs. 1,2,3,4*

Passion Gospel: Mark 15:1–39

Scripture Insert

The customary responses before and after the Gospel are omitted.

The Congregation may be seated for the first part of the Passion. At the indicated place in the Scripture Insert, all stand.

Prayers of the People (Form III)

BCP p. 387

The people may stand or kneel for the Prayers. In the silence after each bidding, prayers may be offered either silently or aloud.

Peace

All stand.

Celebrant The peace of the Lord be always with you.

People And also with you.

Then the Ministers and the People may greet one another in the name of the Lord.

Almighty God, we pray you graciously to behold this your family, for whom our Lord Jesus Christ was willing to be betrayed, and given into the hands of the authorities, and to suffer death upon the cross; who lives and reigns for ever and ever. *Amen.*
