

Response: Psalm 32

Remain seated for the Response.

Second Reading: Romans 5:12-19

Scripture Insert

All stand and remain standing after the hymn.

Holy Gospel: Matthew 4:1-11 Scripture Insert

Celebrant The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Matthew.

People Glory to you, Lord Christ.

After the Gospel is read, the people respond as follows:

Celebrant The Gospel of the Lord.

People Praise to you, Lord Christ.

All stand.

Celebrant The peace of the Lord be always with you.

People And also with you.

The Ministers and the People may greet one another in the name of the Lord.

Offertory Anthem It is Well with My Soul H. Spafford / P. Bliss

Representatives of the congregation bring the people's offerings of bread and wine, and money or other gifts, to the celebrant. The people stand while the offerings are presented and placed on the Altar.

Breaking of the Bread

A period of silence is kept.

Celebrant Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us.

All baptized persons are welcome to receive Holy Communion.

Communion Hymn - H82 #147 Now let us all with one accord Hymnal

Postcommunion Prayer: BCP p. 365

Celebrant and People say the Postcommunion Prayer together

Send us now into the world in peace, and grant us strength and courage to love and serve you with gladness and singleness of heart; through Christ our Lord. Amen.”
