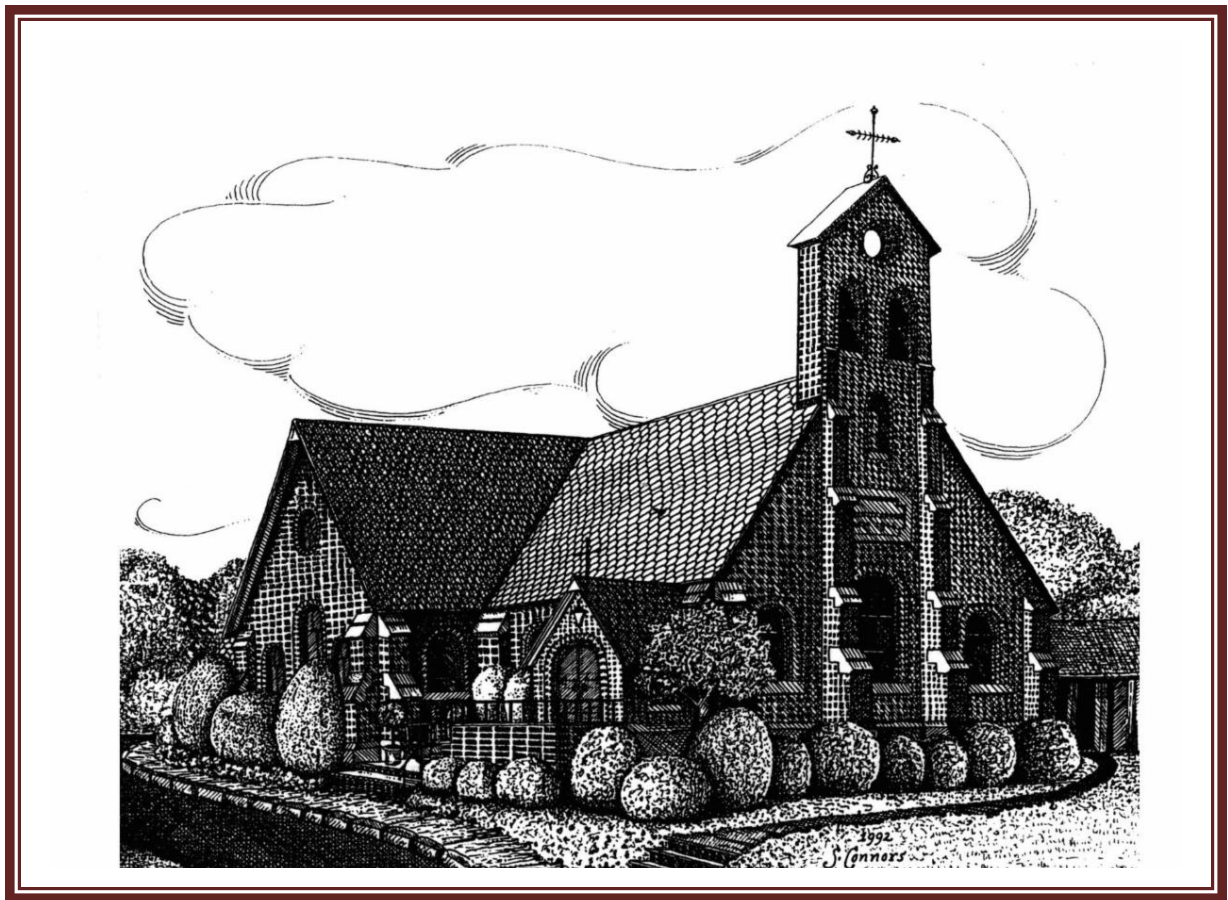

First Reading: Jeremiah 18:1-11 Scripture Insert

All sit for the readings.

After the reading, the people respond as follows:

Reader The Word of the Lord.

People Thanks be to God.

Response: Psalm 139:1-5, 12-17 Scripture Insert

Remain seated for the Response.

Second Reading: Philemon 1:21 Scripture Insert

All stand and remain standing after the hymn.

Sequence Hymn – 423 Immortal, invisible, god only wise Hymnal

Holy Gospel: Luke 14:25-33 Scripture Insert

Celebrant The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke.

People Glory to you, Lord Christ.

After the Gospel is read, the people respond as follows:

Celebrant The Gospel of the Lord.

People Praise to you, Lord Christ.
