Key Responsibilities:

- Leads statewide lottery operations across sales, marketing, games, product development, and data analytics to drive agency performance and strategic goals
- Directs cross-functional teams on major initiatives across retail, digital, and emerging gaming platforms from concept through execution and ongoing improvement
- Develops, evaluates, and implements short- and long-term strategies, policies, and programs to strengthen performance, compliance, and customer engagement
