

## VOTER PROTECTION GUIDELINES

Call the Michelle for Mayor Voter Protection Hotline to report **any of the following on Election Day:**

- **A polling location is not open during polling hours 7:00am to 8:00pm (anyone in line before 8:00pm is entitled to vote)**
- **There are long lines to vote at a polling location**
- **Voters are being turned away from a polling location**
- **Voters are not provided assistance in voting if they ask for it**
- **A polling location has run out of ballots**
- **A polling location is not accessible and/or there is no accessible voting booth**
- **Voters are told they cannot vote because they don't speak English**
- **Voters are not permitted to bring their children into the voting booth with them**
- **Voters are not given a replacement ballot if they ask for it**
- **ANY instance of voter intimidation, harassment, misinformation or other disturbance**

If you witness any of the above issues, you should document them and immediately call our Voter Protection hotline who are in touch with the City of Boston's Election Department.
