## Lesson plan: How to stay super safe online!

**Grades:** 3-6

**Duration:** 60 minutes

### Learning outcomes

Students will:

- Learn five tips that will help keep them safe online
- Fill in the blanks of the Super Safe Story

### Preparation and materials

- Computer, projection screen with internet access and speakers
- Copies of the Super Safe Story (1 per student)
- Colouring and writing materials

### Procedure

As a class, begin by watching the '**5 Internet Safety Tips**' video on YouTube, and guide students through **the PowerPoint deck** viewing the videos and discussing the content.

Lastly, give each student a copy of **The Super Safe Story** where they will practise their learning by filling in the blanks using the internet safety word bank provided.
