Definition:

- A. _____ : Someone you can tell when someone is being mean to you repeatedly online. This person will help you get the right support.
- B. _____ : To take a stand and prevent someone from harming another person, verbally or physically.
- C. _____ : Abusive or threatening language or social media posts that express prejudice, based on ethnicity, religion or gender.
- D. _____ : To intentionally choose not to include someone in a group chat.
- E. _____ : To give your permission: in the digital world, this could mean permission to share a photo of yourself or a private message you sent to a friend.
- F. _____ : To participate or become involved. This could mean you commented on a social media post and laughed at someone who was being made fun of.
- G. _____ : When someone uses blackmail or threats to make someone do something they don't want to do, like send money or an inappropriate photo.
- H. _____ : To welcome others without judgment.
- I. _____ : The use of devices to embarrass, hurt, mock, threaten or be mean to someone online.
- J. _____ : To make a comment with the intention to inflict pain, injury or damage.
