Over 70% of eligible residents have received assistance through this program to attend the AAD's Annual Meeting

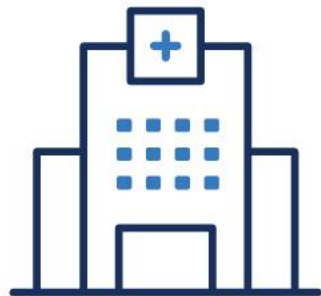

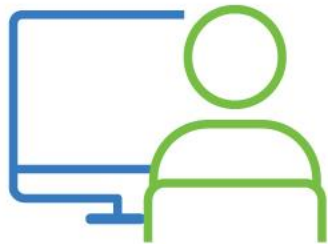

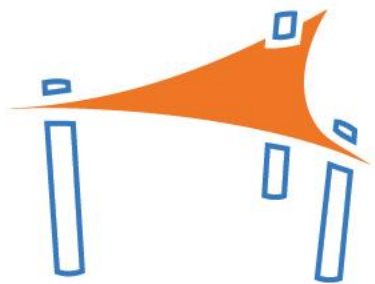
