Airline Tickets

A Fox World Travel air agent will be in contact with you to book your airline tickets when flights are available for your trip. This will be in February of 2019. Please have your passport information ready for the agent.

Arrival

Upon arrival into Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO), you will be greeted by a transportation representative, who will assist you with your bags and direct you to the transfer which will take you to your hotel. Carry-On Baggage

We strongly suggest that you pack a small carry-on bag with such items as: airline documentation, photo identification, prescription medicines, cosmetics and basic toiletries, and other valuables. Please note: you must follow the 3-1-1 rule for liquids packed in your carry-on bag. Liquids must be in a 3 oz. container or smaller, and all containers must fit in a single quart-sized bag.

Airlines allow each person to carry on one bag and one personal item such as a purse, briefcase, or laptop computer. Carry-on bag dimensions should be no more than 9" x 14" x 22" (length x width x height) or 45 linear inches (length + height + width); however, allowances vary by airline. Currency

The official currency is the Tanzanian Shilling. US dollars are widely accepted and preferred over the local currency. All forms of major credit cards are accepted, although it is best to travel with either Mastercard or Visa as these are most widely accepted. Travelers checks are no longer accepted in Tanzania.

Departure

Electrical Outlets

In Tanzania the standard voltage is 230 V and the frequency is 50 Hz. You can use your electric appliances in Tanzania, if the standard voltage in your country is in between 220 - 240 V (as is in the UK, Europe, Australia, and most of Asia and Africa). If you are traveling from the US, American plugs will not work, you will need to bring a plug adapter. If your appliance or charger is not dual voltage, you will need to use a power converter for Tanzania and ensure that it works with 50 Hz.

The local languages are Swahili and English.

Passport & Visa

A valid passport and visa are required for travel to Tanzania. Your passport must be valid for six (6) months after your return date. The name on your airline ticket must match the name on your passport. If it does not match due to a change in marital status, or other life event, you must either have your airline ticket issued according to the name on your passport, or have your passport corrected.
